## Atchison Municipal Court General Diversion Policy

By law, you will absolutely not be granted a diversion for *Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs* (DUI) if:

- 1. You have previously been diverted for an alcohol related offense;
- 2. You have previously been convicted of an alcohol related offense in Kansas:
- 3. You have previously been convicted of a violation of K.S.A. 8-1567 in Kansas or convicted in any other state, municipality or political subdivision for an act which is prohibited by K.S.A. 8-1567; or
- 4. During the time of the alleged alcohol related offense was involved in a motor vehicle accident or collision resulting in personal injury or death.

You will not be granted a diversion for *Driving While Suspended* (DWS) if you have been convicted or diverted for DWS within the past two years; are suspended for DUI or no insurance; or if a prior DWS charge has been amended to no DL in possession within the past two years.

You will not be granted a diversion for *Domestic Violence Battery* if there has been a prior conviction or diversion for *Domestic Violence Battery* in the past two (2) years.

You may be denied diversion for other reasons, such as criminal history, driving history etc. Other factors that will be considered are:

- 1. The nature and the circumstances surrounding the charge;
- 2. The probability that the applicant will cooperate and benefit from the diversion program;
- 3. The impact on the community of placing the applicant on diversion;
- 4. The recommendations of the involved law enforcement officers:
- 5. The recommendations of any victims involved;
- 6. The amount of restitution owed, if any; and
- 7. Any mitigating and aggravating circumstances surround the charge.
